INTRODUCTION

On 30 October 2012, the General Statistics Office's Director General issued the Decision No 6250/QĐ-TCTK on conducting the 2013 Labour Force survey (LFS) and the Project of the 2012 Labour Force survey. The purpose of the survey had collecting basics information on labour market in 2013 in experience comparison with data of previous annual LFS of the General Statistics Office and in accordance with the international standards. The information of this survey is used to assess the fluctuation of labour market among quarters in the years and monitor the influence of economic change on labour market in Vietnam. The synthetic information is presented for the whole country, urban/rural areas; 6 socio-economic regions, Hanoi and Hochiminh city for quarterly and all centrally governed cities/provinces for yearly.

This report has presented major findings of the first quarter 2013 Labour force survey in order to provide information about labour and employment to data users. This survey aim to collect information about main activities relate to labour market for persons aged 15 and above. Therefore, labour market indicators were presented in this report, mainly calculated those aged 15 and above. Because in Vietnam, demand in using labour market indicator for population in working age (15-59 years old for male and 15-54 years old for female), so the results for this age group were separately calculated for some key indicators about unemployment and underemployment.

The 2013 LFS were received technical support from International Labour Organization (ILO). The General Statistics Office highly appreciates this support and would like to continue receiving future support from ILO in the upcoming survey.

The General Statistics Office hope that this report will meet basic demands for information from researchers socio-economic policy makers, especially from those persons related to labour and employment issues and warmly welcome all constructive comments from readers.

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I. SUMMARY

- As of the 1st April 2013, the total working-age population of Vietnam aged 15 years and older was 68.51 million, of which 52.99 million people were in the labour force. Moreover, approximately 70.0% of the labour force in Vietnam was still concentrated in rural areas, despite substantial growth in the urban share of the labour force.
- The labour force participation rate was 77.3% and higher in rural areas (80.8%) than in urban areas (70.3%). In addition, a gender gap in participation is prevalent: female labour force participation is 73.1% and 8.8 percentage points lower than the rate for men.
- The labour force consisted of 51.91 million employed persons and 1.08 million unemployed persons.
- The employment-to-population ratio of the population aged 15 and over in the first quarter of 2013 was 75.8%. However, there were considerable differences between urban and rural areas and between men and women. The urban employment-to-population ratio was 11.9 percentage points lower than the ratio in rural areas, and the male-female gap was 8.6 percentage points.
- In the first quarter of 2013, underemployment increased by 60.8 thousand to 1,555.1 thousand compared to the first quarter of 2012. There were 80.9% underemployed workers were based in rural areas.
- Overall the unemployment rate remained low at 2.27% with the total unemployed population increasing by 98.0 thousand to 1,078.5 thousand compared to the same period of the previous year.
- In regard to young persons aged 15-24, the youth unemployment rate was 6.15% in the first quarter of 2013. Youth accounted for 45.2% of the total unemployed population, with the proportion in urban areas (37.8%) lower than in rural areas (53.4%). Meanwhile, youth underemployment accounted for only 20.3% in total underemployment.
- Among wage workers, average monthly earnings increased on a year-on-year basis by 10.5% to 4,316 thousand dong in the first quarter of 2013.

II. MAJOR FINDINGS

1. Labour Force

1.1 Size and distribution of labour force and labour force participation rate

As of 1st April 2013, the total labour force aged 15 and older in Viet Nam was 52.99 million. Despite an increasing trend in the proportion of the labour force in urban areas, approximately 70% of the labour force in Viet Nam was still concentrated in rural areas. Moreover, 56.8% of the total labour force was based in just three regions: the Red River Delta, the North and South Central Coast and the Mekong River Delta. Female accounted for 48.7% of the total labour force or 25.81 million.

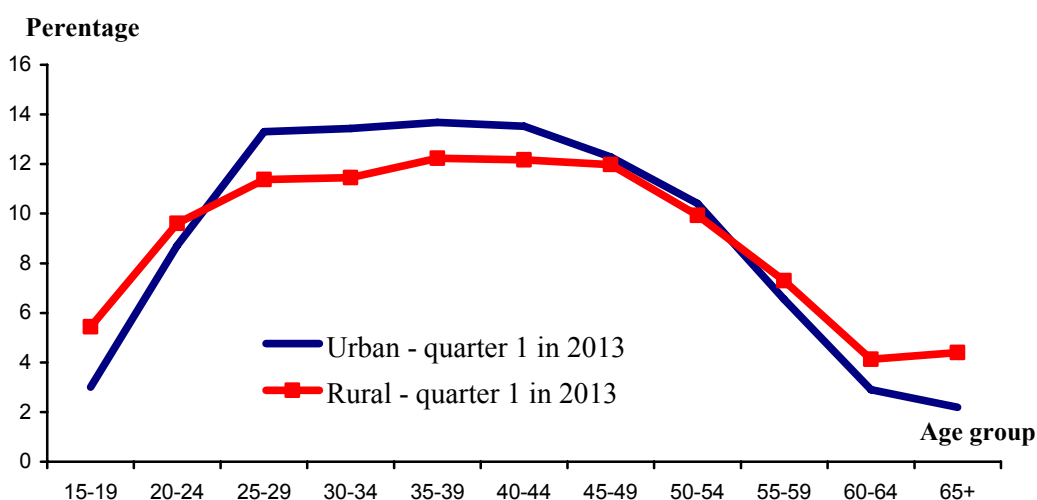
At the national level, the labour force participation rate was 77.3%. The rural labour force participation rate (80.8%) was higher than the rate for urban areas (70.3%). In addition, there were considerable difference between male and female in labour force participation rate, the female labour force

participation rate (73.1%) was lower than the rate for male 8.8 percentage points. Notably, the labour force participation rate was highest in the two mountainous regions of the Northern Midlands and Mountains (84.9%) and Central Highlands (83.0%). Meanwhile, it was lowest in the two largest socio-economic centres of Viet Nam, namely in Hanoi (70.5%) and Ho Chi Minh City (64.6%).

1.2 Age structure of labour force

The distribution of the labour force by age group provides some context of the demographic and socio-economic situation. Viet Nam has a relatively young labour force, with over one-half (51.5%) of the labour force less than 40 years old.

There were substantial differences in the age structure of the labour force between urban and rural areas (Figure 1). The share of youth (aged 15-24) and older persons (aged 55 years and older) in the labour force of urban areas is lower than in rural areas. In contrast, the proportion of the labour force in the prime working age group (aged 25-54) was higher for urban areas than for rural areas. This pattern could reflect higher participation in education for urban youth in comparison to rural youth, and longer working lives for older persons in rural areas.

2. Employment

Table 2 shows the distribution of the employed population by sex and region and the employment-to-population ratio of the first quarter in 2013. 70.4% of all workers were based in rural areas, while females made up 48.7% of the total employed population. In terms of regions, the North and South Central Coast and the Mekong River Delta accounted for 22.0% and 19.5% of total employment, respectively. The employment-to-population ratio stood at 75.8% in the first quarter 2013.

In the first quarter of 2013, the employed population decreased by 20.7 thousand people compared to the fourth quarter of 2012. In 8 regions, only two region North and South Central Coast and Central Highlands had increase in employment compared to the fourth quarter of 2012 (250.3 thousand and 38.3 thousand respectively), 6 remain region decreased compared to the fourth quarter of 2012, mainly in Hanoi (78.8 thousand) and Southeast (56.0 thousand). On a year-on-year basis from the first quarter of 2012, total employment increased by 912.3 thousand, or by 1.79%.

The employment-to-population ratio was 75.8% in the first quarter of 2013. There was a considerable differential in the employment-to-population ratio between urban and rural. The employment-to-population ratio in urban areas was lower than rural areas by 11.9 percentage points.

By socio-economic region, the highest employment-to-population ratio were observed in two mountainous regions, namely Northern Midlands and Mountains and Central Highlands, and the lowest were in two most economically developed centres of Hanoi city and Ho Chi Minh city.

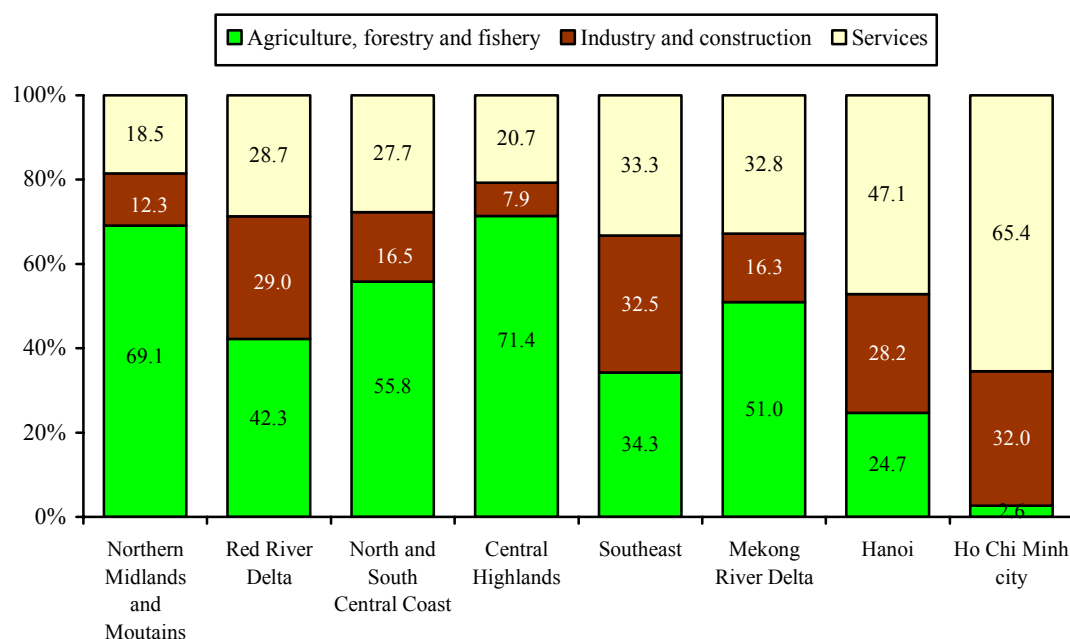

Figure 2 presents the proportion of employed population by industrial sector for each region. The data show that Ho Chi Minh city has the most developed economic structure, with 97.4% of employed population working in industry, construction or services. In the mountainous and coastal areas, the proportion of workers based in the agriculture, forestry and fishery sector remained quite high: 71.4% in the Central Highlands; 69.1% in the Northern Midlands and Mountains and 55.8% in the North and South Central Coast.

3. Underemployment and unemployment

3.1 Underemployed and unemployed population

In the first quarter of 2013, there were 1555.1 thousand underemployed persons and a population of 1078.5 thousand unemployed. Compared to the same period of the previous year, underemployment increased by about 60.8 thousand and unemployment by 98.0 thousand. In addition, 80.9% of the underemployed population were rural-based, and 59.1% were men. There were 52.1% unemployment based in urban and 52.3% were men.

In the first quarter of 2013, youth accounted for 45.2% of the total unemployed, with the proportion in urban areas (37.8%) lower than in rural areas (53.4%). Meanwhile, youth accounted for only 20.3% of the total underemployed population. Youth unemployment has become important challenges for society, given their vulnerability to fluctuations in the labour market.

3.2 Underemployment rate and unemployment rate

The underemployment and unemployment rates presented below are calculated for the population of the statutory working age (including persons aged 15-59 years old for males and 15-54 years old for females). In Vietnam, the urban unemployment rate (3.80%) was higher than in rural areas (1.58%). There were little difference in unemployment rate among males and females. The unemployment rate across regions was very different with that of Ho Chi Minh city being the highest (3.67%).

The rural underemployment rate (3.63%) was higher than the urban rate (1.95%). Among the differences regions, the Mekong River Delta had highest underemployment rate (5.41%).

Despite slower economic growth, the unemployment rate in Vietnam changed not much. For example, the urban unemployment rate (3.8%) in the first quarter of 2013 was hardly unchanged, just increased little compared to the first quarter of 2012 (3.46%). This could be explained in part by the low

level of development of the economy, where living standards are not high, the social security system is not developed and workers must stay employed, even in the informal sector where earnings are low and unstable, in order to support themselves and their family.

The unemployment rate for youth was calculated for persons aged 15-24 and adult unemployment rate for persons aged 25 and above. The youth unemployment rate in urban was 4.5 times higher than the adult rate (11.28% compared to 2.49%). The youth unemployment rate in the first quarter of 2013 increased 1.73 percentage points compared to the fourth quarter of 2012 and 2.55 percentage points compared to the same period of previous year.
