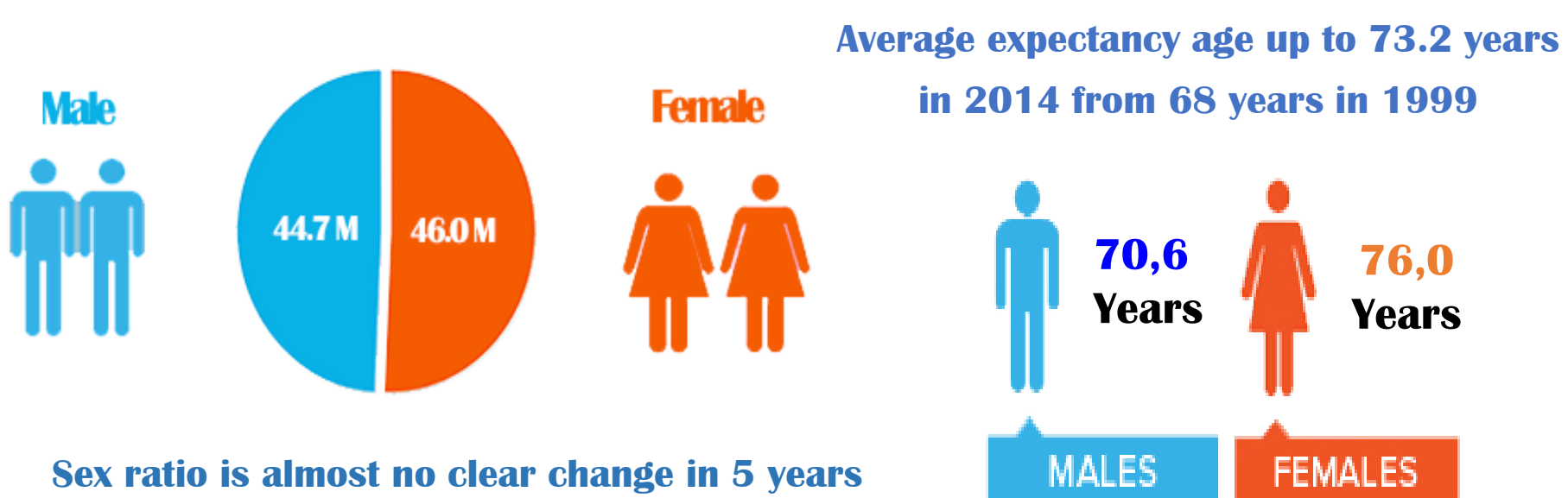


VIETNAM POPULATION 2014

In 2014, the Viet Nam's population reaches 90.7 million and this impressive figure would make Vietnam continued ranking the 3rd most populous country in ASEAN and the 13th most populous country in the world. Due to decreasing fertility and increasing life expectancy, Viet Nam's population structure has dramatically changed over time and will continue in the decades to come.

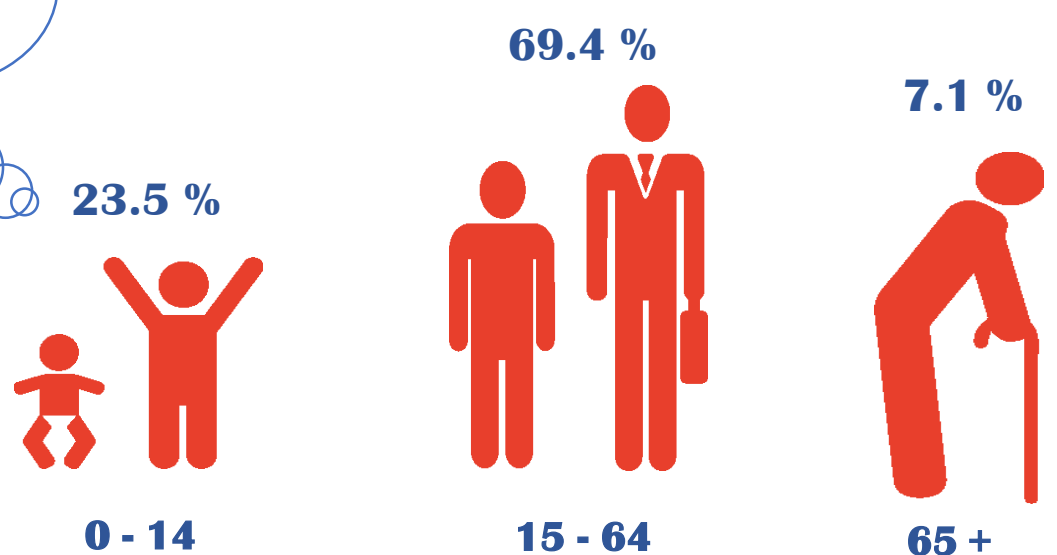


POPULATION GROWTH RATE TOTAL FERTILITY RATE CRUDE BIRTH RATE



With the total dependency ratio was 44 dependents for every 100 working age people, Viet Nam is still in the "golden population structure" period

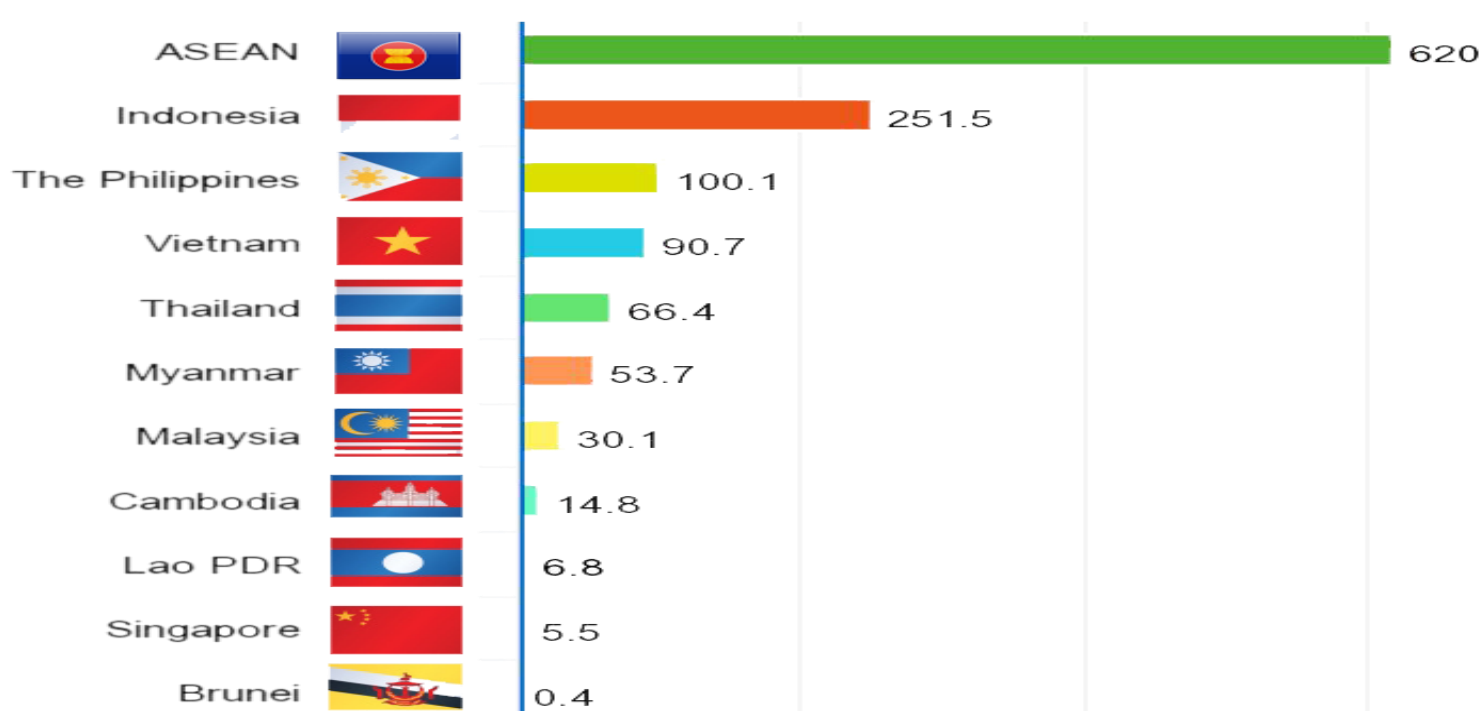
AGE STRUCTURE 2014



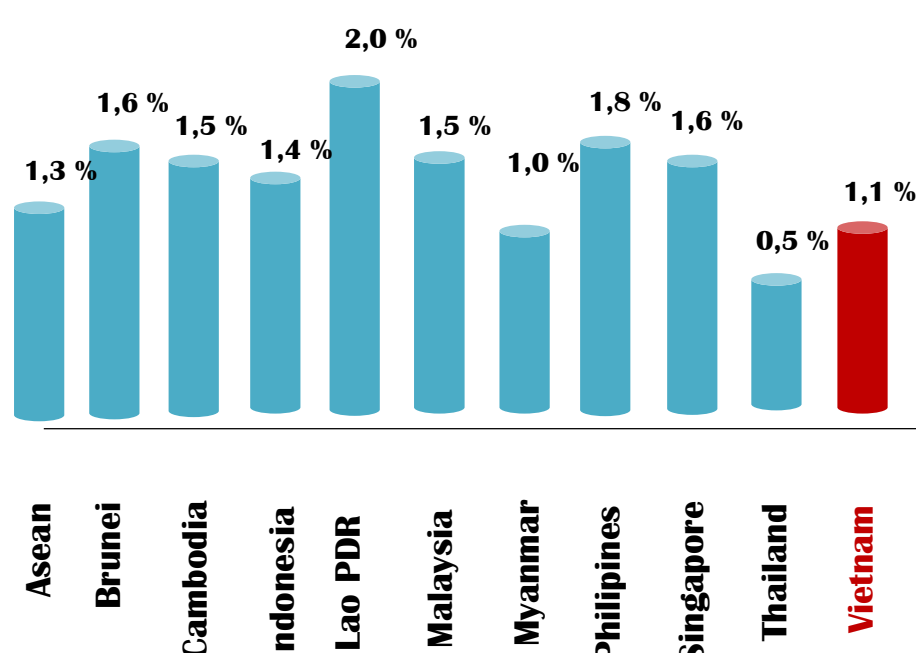
